POLISH LANGUAGE COURSES Katowice

(all levels of advance)

General information:

- each course begins with a placement test and ends with final exam,
- participants at every level of advance are given the certificate to confirm their attitude and grades,
- one class hour lasts 45 minutes, actual prices of courses are available on website: www.sjikp.us.edu.pl (part: courses).

♦ Courses:

• Semester course of Polish language

- 60 class hours,
- classes in groups, twice a week (between 8 a.m. and 7 p.m.),
- meetings during which Polish traditions and celebrations are presented,
- the School gives credit points (ECTS) for each semester of the course,
- Erasmus students, scholars and University of Silesia faculty staff do not pay for the course,
- students and faculty staff of other universities pay only manipulative charge.

• A la carte courses (in the group or individual)

— the lengths of the course, intensity, fee and place of classes are flexible and possible to negotiate.

One month intensive course

- 60 class hours.
- minimum 4 students in the group.

One year intensive course

- 450 class hours,
- minimum 5 students in the group.

Course preparing for the Polish as

Foreign Language State Examination Certificate

- preparations for exams in Polish on levels,
- classes help to develop language skills tested on the exam and complete missing vocabulary, grammar
- intensity and frequency of the course is to be decided.

Polish Language Course for Foreigners Planning to Study the Humanities

- 780 class hours during two semesters, minimum 6 students in the group,
- course arranged on the order of the Ministry of Science and Higher Education, starts in October,
- prepares language abilities necessary to study in Polish,
- final exam empowers to obtain course diploma which states candidate's level of advance in Polish,
- Polish Government scholars do not pay for the course.

♦ Rules of participation

- over 18 years old,
- filled in application form,
- bringing to the School office confirmation of payment.

♦ Organization information

- in case of resignation of the course School pays back the fee minus vadium,
- accommodation: on participant's request School can book a room in a dormitory, costs of the room
 are covered by the student (course fee does not include accommodation),
- filling in application form and paying vadium enables to receive the confirmation of planned course
- School does not take responsibility of visa or permit of stay.
