*The ninth youth conference will take place in a parallel with the VII International scientific-practical conference **“State and legal systems of the Asia-Pacific region countries: formation of a polycentric world order and opportunities of international law and comparative law”** (see separate informational letter <https://yadi.sk/i/xyxRE48a3RFf2e>)*

The aim of the conference is to strengthen the international legal cooperation between states, the scientific communities and youth of Russia, countries of Asian-Pacific region (APR), and other countries.

Objectives:

- establishment and development of business relations with other scientists, universities, research institutions and centers of comparative law researches.
- assisting the cooperation between Russia and APR countries, other states, in the judicial and law enforcement affairs, human rights sphere.
- evolution of comparativistics towards the development of didactics, the quality of training future lawyers in APR countries.

Russia is the biggest Eurasian country. Geographically, most of its territory is a part of Asia, which largely determines the prospects for the development of the entire region. The success of the political, commercial and economic, cultural cooperation between Russia and the countries of Asia is largely determined by how deeply we understand the legislation particularities, legal and general culture of neighboring countries and assess all the difference. Due to this fact, comparative researches in various fields of knowledge, including the rights, have become especially relevant. Strong scientific potential of universities and research institutions is required for its implementation.

Arrangements committee traditionally has increased focus on the youth audience of the conference. Dear young scientists and law executors, postgraduates, undergraduates and students! Now, present or in the near future you will take a full responsibility not only for the development of your own country, but also for the strengthening of friendship and cooperation

in the Asian-Pacific region, in the whole world. The lawyers with knowledge of oriental languages, possessing the technique of special translation, familiar with the legislation of Russia and other APR countries in comparative legal aspect will become in-demand. Even now, in your professional qualifications, you can focus on Asia. And this direction can give you, the future and the current young lawyers, high guarantees of a successful employment and a brilliant career!

International scientific-practical conference of young scientists, post-graduates, undergraduates and students “Comparative law in the Asian-Pacific Region-IX” given by us for the -9th time evokes a great interest both in Russia and in other leading countries in the Asian-Pacific Region such as China, Japan, Mongolia, South Korea, India as well as the CIS countries. The universities, research centers of Europe and other countries are actively cooperating with us in the given direction.

The conference traditionally works with five sections:

Section Nr.1. **“Constitutional legal and administrative legal problems of Comparative Law in the countries of APR”**.

Section Nr.2. **“International law and international relations”**.

Section Nr.3. **“Civil legal problems of Comparative Law in the countries of APR”**.

Section Nr.4. **“Criminal legal and criminological problems of Comparative Law in the countries of APR”**.

Section Nr.5. **“Criminal procedures and criminalistics problems of Comparative Law. Law enforcement authorities in the countries of APR”**.

Within the framework of the youth scientific forum there will be held roundtables on the following themes:

- “Protection of rights and lawful interests of citizens of Mongolia in the territory of the Russian Federation and Russian citizens in the territory of Mongolia”;
- “Anti-criminal education in the world practice and the participation of law universities, students in its implementation”.

The recommended subject can be corrected and expanded by a researcher. However the report theme is defined by frameworks of **comparative law** of APR countries. Based on the conference results the publication of scientific papers is planned. The collection volume will be indexed with RISC, will have DOI and IDSP numbers as well as SPLN-code and QR-Code<sup>1</sup>. The conference materials, including multimedia presentations, will be published on a website of BSU <http://www.bsu.ru/university/departments/faculties/uf/13244/>. Authors of the best works will be assisted in the grants and the placement of their research papers in leading peer-reviewed publications.

The roundtables will take place on June 27 and 29, 2018. The exact time and place can be found in the program of the youth conference, which will be sent by email at least 3 days before the start of the scientific event.

In the framework of preparation for the conference on June 25, 2018 will be held a master class on the subject: “The methodology of public speaking at conferences” (holding by Y.P. Garmaev, Doctor of Juridical Science, Professor, the head of the arrangements committee).

To participate in the forum, it is required to send the application before June 10, 2018 to the Arrangements Committee in electronic form in Russian or English languages (application form attached below), the text of the report (article), as well as a copy of the payment receipt of registration fee (see below the details).

Multimedia presentations for intramural participation should be submitted no later than June 15, 2018 (advice on drawing up presentations, see, for example: <http://dgorlin.blogspot.ru/2010/01/10-kak-delat-prezentaciyu-10-sovetov.html>).

### **Requirements to the Articles**

1. Article is represented in the electronic form in Russian or in native language (in case of second option, the article should be additionally translated into English; in such cases it is possible to publish the article in both languages) as a separate file: in a file name it is necessary to specify a surname of the author and first three words of the name of article (in Russian or English).

2. Arrangements Committee requires the authors to carefully check before submitting a common spelling and punctuation of the materials, as well as the spelling of the relevant juridical terms, references to normative legal acts, etc.

3. Materials of postgraduates, graduates and students will be accepted only after being checked by your scientific supervisor. The written review is not required, but the arrangement committee reserves the right to contact with the supervisor if needed.

4. The size of article should be about 8 pages.

The text is written in “Microsoft Word” (no later than MS Word 2007) using Times New Roman (size 14), a line spacing – 1,5. Position on page – on width of the text. Fields: all – 20 mm. A paragraph – 1,25. Pages should be not numbered.

5. Article title must be in the center of page with bold-face type capital letters.

6. Information about the author (authors) are specified under the title of article with bold-face type lower case letters, alignment should be on a right edge (Full name, the organization, city, country).

7. References in the article should be placed in square brackets with instructions of serial number of a source and page number: [1, p. 5].

8. The list of the sources must be in the alphabetical order after the text under a heading “Literature” with numbering of each source in the Arabian figures. Inclusion of electronic resource is necessarily.

9. Each article will be checked on presence of borrowings by “Anti-plagiarism” system<sup>2</sup>.

All expenses connected with the conference (trip, accommodation, food, cultural program, etc.) are covered by the participants or the sending organization correspondingly.

BSU hotel booking is provided till June 10, 2018. The number of rooms is limited. Accommodation fee is paid by cash on a check-in day.

**Cultural program** visits to Buddhist and other sights of Buryatia. The excursion to the Lake Baikal and/or to the “Summer law school on the Lake Baikal” which is planned on June 30, 2018 – July 01, 2018 and will be held with the participation of leading Russian and foreign scientists as speakers, with yoga classes, meditation and other Oriental practices. The Summer school program will be sent later.

In the case of trip to Baikal Lake it is recommended to buy tickets back not earlier than 22.00 of local time (+5 from Moscow) on July 01, 2018.

**Participations of the conference are free from paying the participation fee.**

The conference program includes guided tour and departure to lake Baikal (approximate cost – 5 000 RUB per 1 day).

**Article publication fee is 500 rubles** (payment for 1 copy of the collection volume), plus the cost of mailing (to be determined when sending cash on delivery).
